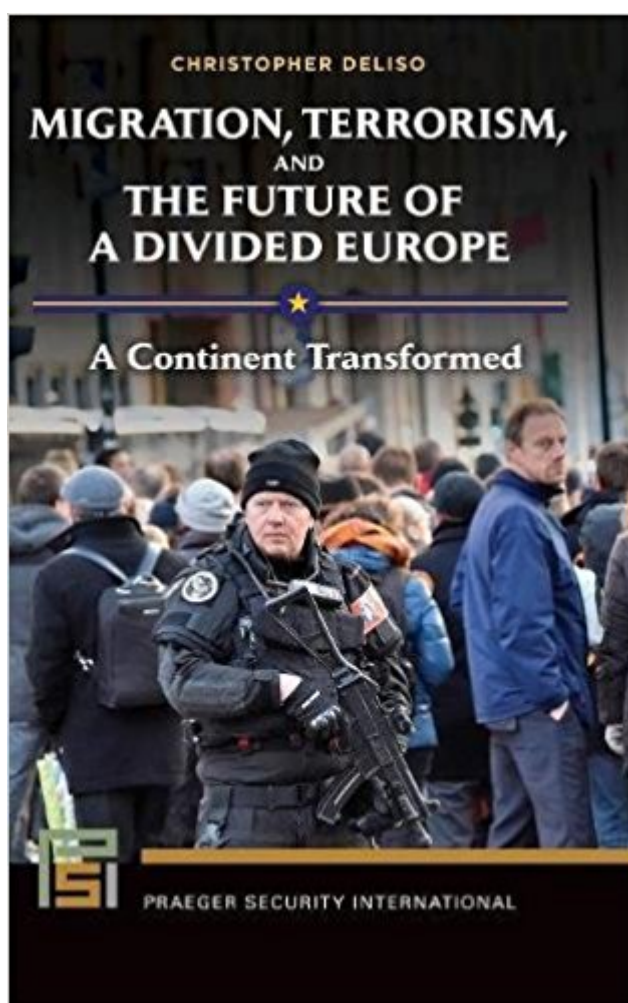


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Migration, Terrorism, And The Future Of A Divided Europe: A Continent Transformed (Praeger Security International)
