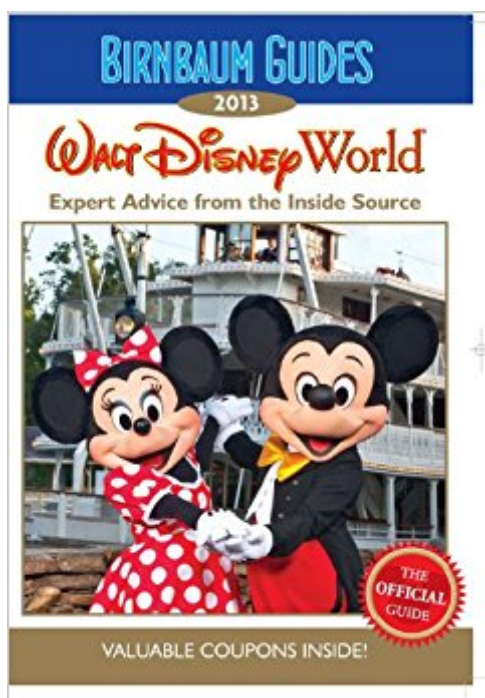

I purchased this book to give to our 8 year-old grandson about 2 months before our trip which will be his first time to Disney World. I'm already fairly familiar with WDW having been there 5 times within the last 5 years, but this book is still very helpful because it gives a kid an opportunity to look through and choose some of the attractions they are especially interested in checking out. It helps build excitement for the trip. The plentiful pictures in the book helped me to become familiar with the names of the rides that are geared for kids his age that my husband and I skip over when we go ourselves. With that knowledge I also know how to find these attractions in the theme parks. The only reason I did not give it 5 stars is because some of the pictures captured his attention so quickly that he made decisions on wanting to experience them without having a better idea of what to expect. Having bought the Birnbaum book for kids, I thought I would treat myself to the one for adults. The book is very user friendly and the pictures of what I'm about to experience are getting me that much more excited for my trip. Though not as detailed as the Unofficial book, this book feels more like a Cliff's Notes version with pretty images. Everything is pretty clear cut and straight forward but doesn't really give you as much insight than other guides. If you're looking for something easy to read with nice presentation, then this is the book for you. If you are looking for something that's got more depth and insight, then I would purchase the Unofficial Guide by Bob Sehlinger and Len Testa.

We bought this for our 7 years old niece and she loved it. It was great in that it helped her get more involved on the trip ahead of it, and it was always with her in the parks, to get autographs and read, as well as she cherishes it now after the trip. Since the trip involved flying, I also want to point out the following book to help with the travelling experience and make it more fun [Going on a Plane Sticker Book \(Usborne First Experiences\)](#). This was also very helpful in making the overall experience better.

If you've never been to WDW or have no other reference books that cover dining, this is a good

book. If you want a thin book to take along with you to the parks to make quick, last-minute decisions, this is a good book as well. I wouldn't use this for critical or popular reviews of restaurants at WDW. The focus is primarily on describing the type of food and service -- there isn't even a "star" rating on restaurants. If you're a Disney vet or have a Passport, this is superfluous.

This is by far the best and most detailed planning guide for Walt Disney World. The original has always been the best guide. Disney World is so large and ever changing landscape you must plan your stay to get the most bang for your time. This guide breaks down areas and gives good advice depending on the time of year you plan to visit.
