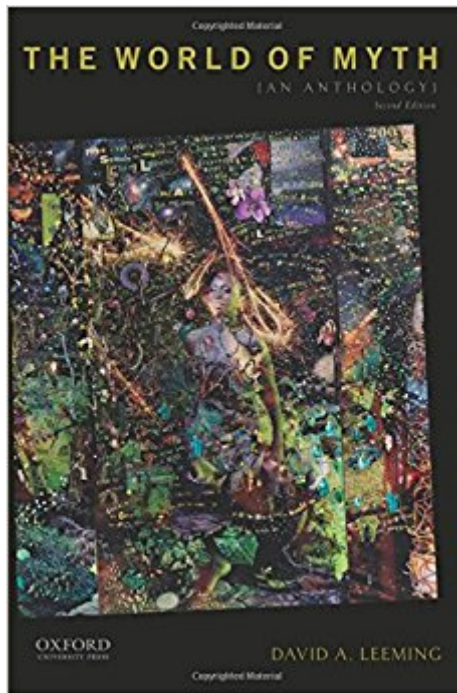

David Leeming is Professor Emeritus of English at the University of Connecticut in Storrs. He is the author of many books on mythology, including *The Oxford Companion to World Mythology* (2005).

This is an update of the first edition, and it is quite different. Leeming has added a bunch of material to the first, and dropped some things. At first I was excited to get it, but it did not live up to my hopes. The first drawback is that the new stuff is often just analysis rather than the stories themselves. This seems pointless: why give analysis of something the reader isn't familiar with? Also, Leeming often just quotes himself from his other books, so the new material seems tired and sketchy. The other drawback is that he has dropped some of the best things, like *Hiawatha* and some others. This is a shame, for they perfectly illustrated his whole archetype motif. I would recommend getting the first edition. Plus, it's lots cheaper, and you can buy them even cheaper used.
