

Synopsis

Years after a devastating battle, Mahingan and his tribe struggle to recover a lost loved one. Six years earlier in the fourteenth century, Mahingan and his tribe fought the Battle of the Falls against the Haudenosaunee. Then, an influential MiÃ¢ ¸kmaq legend puts a new, powerful twist on events, and threatens to send things spiraling out of MahinganÃ¢ ¸s control.
