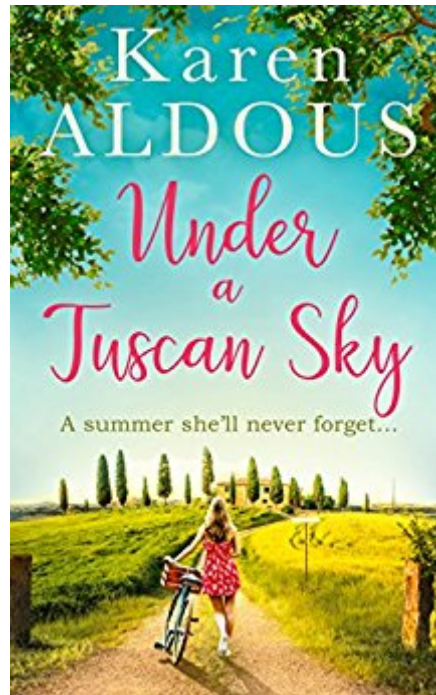




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Under A Tuscan Sky

Olivia has broken up with her long term boyfriend. She is taking a short trip to Tuscany in order to clear out and sell her late grandmother's home. She is a very self contained 40 year old woman who makes notes about everything. She envisions her future as a woman alone in the world and she is making peace with that future. Which meant I was surprised when she gets on the plane to fly to Italy, and suddenly is having a lustful thoughts about a handsome man. When he describes their future together and their children, she simply goes along with it. Later there is another man who wants to buy her Nonna's home and the minute she sees him, she is immediately enamored. All of this seems to me to be rather out of character for the woman who has been described to us. For me, this complete turn around was jarring. A great deal of this story is a journey for Olivia as she seeks to find out her family's history. There are surprises and things she thought she understood are not as they appeared. People were not exactly who they seemed. The book is well written. The plot seems to bog down at times, but the basic plot is interesting. The character development seems to go in fits and starts. I think I would have been more comfortable with the story if Olivia had gradually changed her attitude. I am not sure it is human nature for someone who is so cautious in life to suddenly decide to jump into relationships. I received this book from the publisher through NetGalley.
