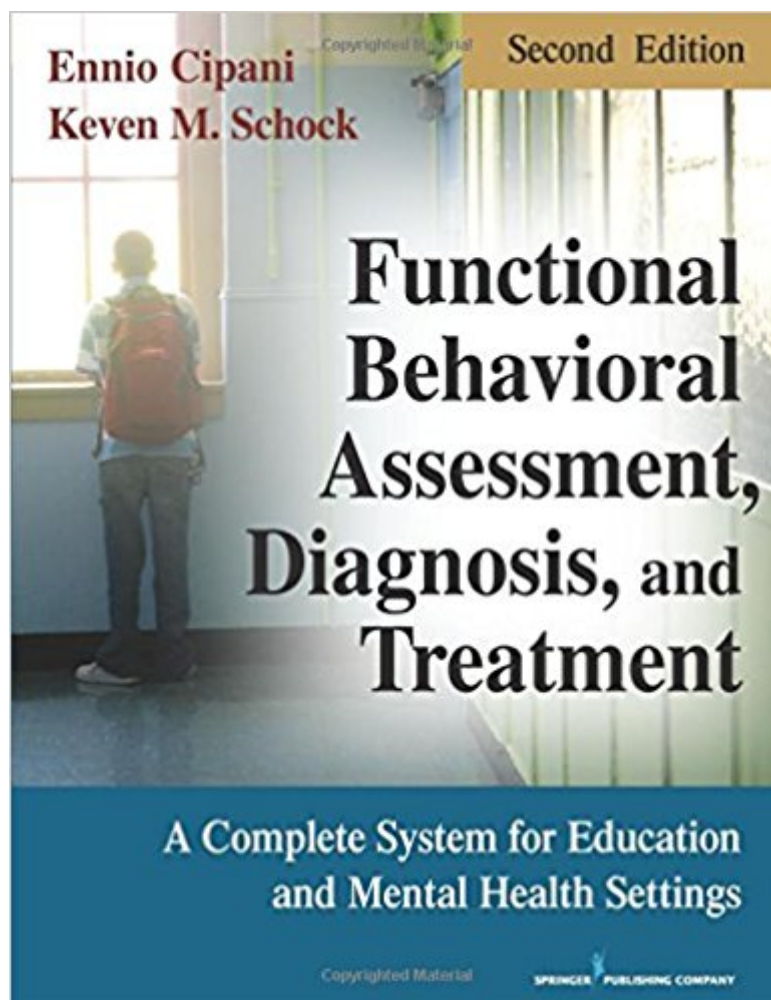

I must thank Dr. Cipani and Shock for presenting Functional Assessment of Behavior in Depth and with great clarity in this book. The most enriching feature is that the examples are from a variety of settings - autistic children, adult care homes, class room behavior of typically developing children, foster homes etc. It gives a lucid presentation of methodological problems and how to overcome them- read especially on how they treat the subject of making recording ABC data meaningful. There is much more subtlety to this exercise than one suspected from a preliminary understanding. The language used strikes a good balance between being technical and intelligible.
