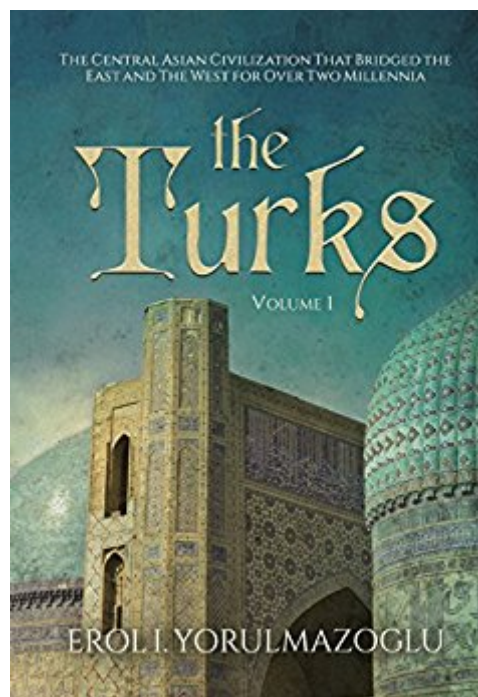


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The Turks: The Central Asian Civilization That Bridged The East And The West For Over Two Millennia (Turkish History Book 1)
