

Beginning with pertinent information on normal speech production, this introductory text then introduces students to the transcription of consonants and vowels, connected speech, and individuals with speech sound disorders. Students also learn the transcription of regional and ethnic dialectal variations of speech. Throughout the well-organized text, CD icons, learning exercises, objectives, and study questions help students learn and process the text's material.

A complete revision of the clinical phonetics chapter (Chapter 7) includes updated information on speech sound disorders. Readers are provided with expanded coverage relative to the transcription of disordered speech using both diacritical markings and non-English IPA symbols. A complete revision of the dialects chapter (Chapter 8) provides the reader with more current information and contemporary perspectives on how native language impacts learning of a second language. New and updated exercises throughout the text supplement the new written material and ensure that every learning tool is up-to-date and relevant. Online resources are listed at the end of each chapter, allowing students to learn more about the material they have just covered or to research topics that especially interest them. References have also been updated throughout the text to keep the text current and accurate. I was pleasantly surprised by this textbook! For one, I can't remember the last time, if ever, I went

through an entire textbook in a class. Normally we get part way through. Then you're stuck with half a book you're never going to touch again. But this book was useful from cover to cover. Not just useful, but engaging. I went into the course knowing nothing about phonetics, but between the teacher and the text, I now feel very competent. The activities really help you learn, and the CDs are surprisingly useful accompaniments. I can't sell this book back because it is absolutely filled with writing and highlighter, but I wouldn't sell it back even if I could. I'm actually going to keep it and probably end up referring to it because it is so handy. I would definitely recommend this text for teachers selecting a book for their phonetics classes. Probably the best textbook I've ever been assigned to use.
