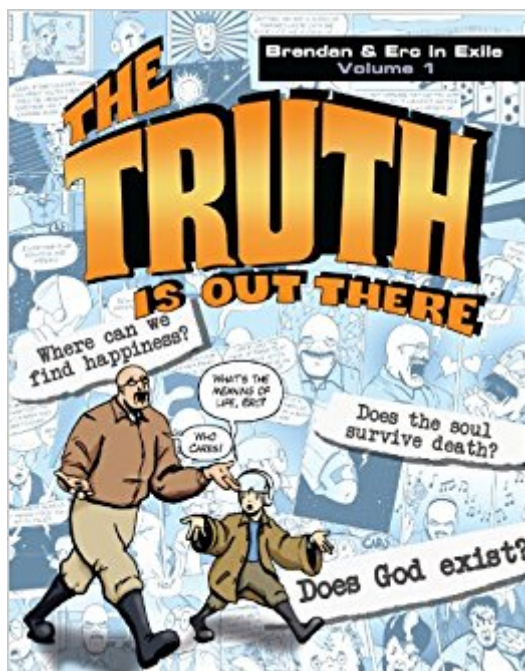

Amadeus is a contemplative monk in Massachusetts. Since having entered the cloister in 2003, he lives a life of prayer, adoration, work and study. Although he has experience with comic strips in his past, this is his first full length graphic novel (or Intruc-Toons as he likes to call it). A portion of the proceeds from the sale of this book will help support the Maronite Monks of Adoration.

I wasn't expecting much from a graphic novel but my sons like them, so I picked it up out of curiosity. The combination of Catholic and animation seemed like it would be at least a small win. I was mostly hoping that it wouldn't be too corny or too over the top. It was neither. The boys picked the book up right away and immediately began laughing, discussing, and asking questions. Sometimes it goes a bit above their heads, but that's a good opportunity for discussion. These two fellows, Brendan and Eric, go through a series of events and meet a variety of people as they find their way to "The Truth". The reader is introduced to some deep and philosophical concepts without having to break open the tomes of the Church Doctors. It builds a bit of a foundation and I do believe that when they decide to read the works of our saints they will have an easier time of it. I should confess that I enjoyed reading it, too. Bring on Volume 2!

As an atheist convert I will say this is the most persuasive and fun book I have read. It's an excellent book for anybody interested in the Truth. It takes the reader from knowing nothing all the way to the church Christ founded in a fun, easy, and informative way.
