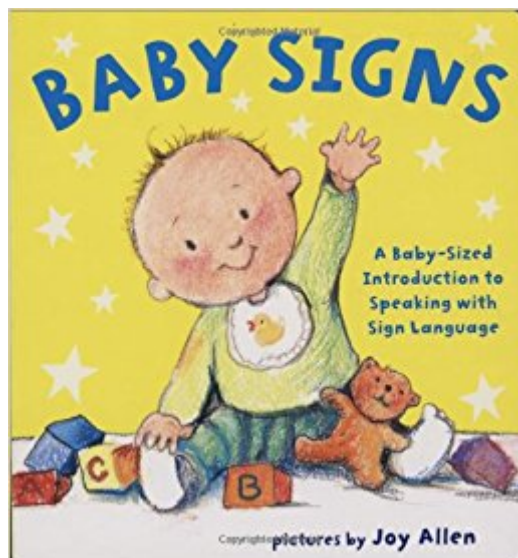

When flipping through the first two books I became a little overwhelmed, but then I got to this one... it is perfect for beginning to learn sign language. It has 14 very basic and often used signs. I started doing these signs when my son was about 4 1/2 months old. Most commonly 'milk'.
