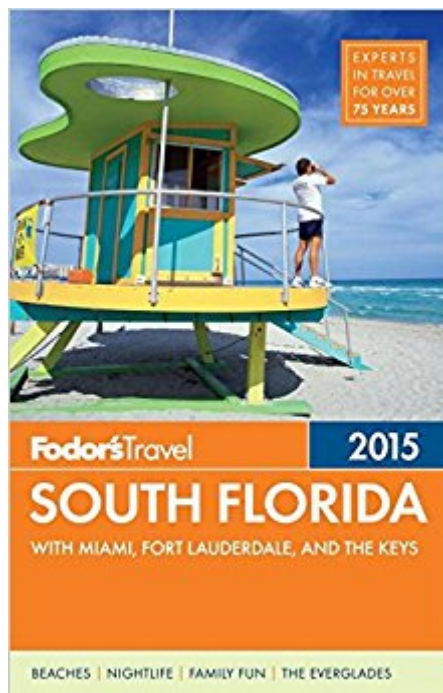

My husband and I like to have travel guide book with us when we go on vacation.

We've taken both Frommers and Fodors in the past, but we decided on Fodors for our Miami/Florida Keys trip since it looked like it had more information on the Keys, where we would be spending most of our trip, while the Frommers looked like it was mostly Miami. We were not disappointed! There were sections for each group of keys - upper, middle and lower - and there

were great recommendations for accommodations and places to eat in each section. We were staying pretty laid back on this trip, so we weren't looking for tons of things to do, but this book had a enough information about each of the islands we stayed on to give us interesting ideas of what to do. There was also information about visiting the Everglades, which we decided to do on our way from Miami to the keys. There was a pull out map, which we didn't end up using. It was a nice feature nonetheless. One critique I have was that we found the hotel price ranges in the book didn't always match up with what we found when we were booking our stays. It wasn't a major problem, but it did make it a little more difficult booking hotels. Overall it was a helpful book for our vacation!

I purchased this book in advance of a trip to Miami and the surrounding area. It is chalked full of information and great recommendations. It also contains some good maps. My only complaint is that the big map at the back is of the entire state with smaller maps of Miami and Orlando. I would rather have a large blow up of the greater Miami area, since the book covers south Florida and not the entire state.

Went to the Keys. It really only had the very commercial things in there. Nothing wrong with that, but not what i was looking for 100% of the time. Had another guide book for the Everglades and Keys that was more helpful, more personable (strongly discouraging people to swim with captive dolphins for example!) and much more local: Best of The Florida Keys & Everglades (Open Road Travel Guides) by Morris

Good for the basics. It doesn't seem to have been written by people intimately familiar with the area. I wish there were more "off the beaten path" insights.

Even in this day of TripAdvisor and other on-line sites, it's still good to have a printed reference available. On a recent trip to South Florida, this book was a good addition as we traveled between South Beach and Key West.
