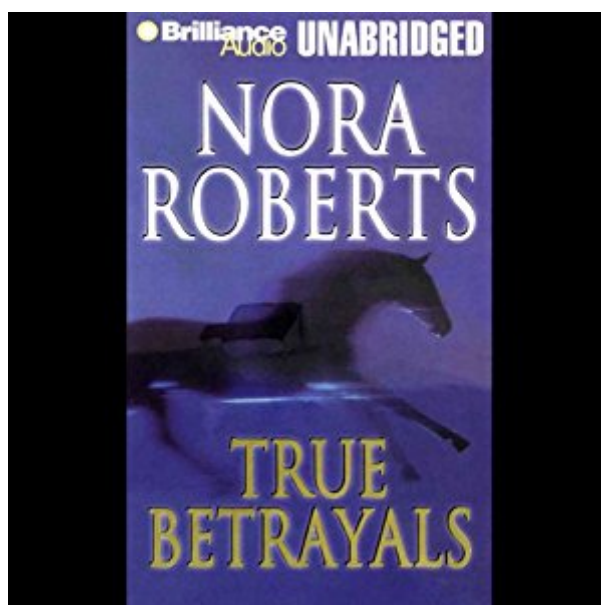

I think this may be my favorite of Nora's books (and I have so many I love). I love all of the characters, but the story between Naomi and Kelsey holds a special place for me. It's so beautiful! It's always great to have a story where you love the main characters, but even better when you have a wonderful variety of supporting players. This book is perfectly balanced with both. I hate for it to end. It's one of those where you just want more.

Overall I really liked the story line, thought that the book was well paced and it definitely held my interest. There are a number of twists and turns but overall character development of the major

players (primary and secondary) was lacking, especially in terms of depth and left me disappointed. What there was just shaped my appetite for deeper development. That is the reason I rated the book 3.5. There was some good developing sexual tension between Kelsey and Gabe but a lack of sex scenes.
