

It was great to find a new collection of McManus stories. I'm not an outdoors-man, but I've read all of his books except for the one dealing with kid camping and thoroughly enjoyed them. While his settings frequently involve hunting, camping or fishing, those are just the backdrop to the situations his characters get into. McManus' writing provides just enough detail to put the reader in the right frame of mind, yet allows the reader to fill in any of the missing descriptions as s/he sees fit. While some of the the stories in *The Horse in My Garage and Other Stories* are similar to stories in his other books and even within this one, I still found them humorous--and interesting to see alternative ways they could have been written and which way turned out more humorous. Whether reading about his misadventures as an outdoors-man or as a mischievous (curious/inventive) boy in the pre-World War II era, this book was a blast to read and caused me to laugh out loud several times.

I love books by Patrick McManus. They are neither thrilling nor intellectually challenging. They are just funny and for me a bit nostalgic. I recall many years ago bringing several to fish camp. There was less than normal sleep since somebody was always giggling while reading them...we'd all had similar experiences.

This is a delightful collection of essays by an engaging writer. I laughed out loud several times and could not contain my smiles throughout. McManus populates his writing with an entertaining cast of characters whom we get to know from one piece to another. A thoroughly good read.

This wasn't as deftly crafted as his earlier works, and I probably won't read it again and again as I did those, but it is a delight to find a new McManus. Several entertaining biographical pieces and a couple of chapters right up there with his older stuff. Kudos to Patrick!
