Wow, it's been so long that I came by a good book about vampires. This series so far is great. It's captivating, very well written there are hardly any typos and just everything is right, for me at least. The way it is written just gets to you. The second volume in the "Beautiful Monsters" series is just as satisfying as the first, although it's much more tragic for our hero. Matthew has broken free of the incubi, and he is now living as a vampire in vampire society. He still has a lot to learn, and while he is not without the assistance of a powerful vampire to help him understand, Matthew (being Matthew) stumbles through learning the hard way. He learns much about himself and about his past in this book, and a new enemy arises that forces the Incubi and the Vampires to work together. (And why would anyone think that opening a hell mouth would be a good idea?) There are new characters here, as well as familiar faces. We have Matthew, of course, the hero - and he is such a well-crafted and believable character that his motivations and flaws make perfect sense, because as a reader, you begin to feel that you really know him. The point of view in this work is his, and it is perfect. At no point does he break character, not in speech or action and not in the narrative. There are a number of other characters in this world with Matthew, too. We have Tarrick, who is just as complex as he was in "Captive". We have Silva, whose emotional backstory gets more play, and the new characters Devak and Sam, whose impact on Matthew cannot be understated. I said this in my review of the first book, "Captive," and it still holds true. The books are told from Matthew's point of view, and that point of view has such integrity

and is so well-crafted that I sometimes felt that I was reading a first-person account. I am eagerly looking forward to Book 3 in the Beautiful Monsters series. Jex Lane is a talent, and I hope to read her work for years to come. Anyone looking for an involving series with deep emotion, strongly-rendered characters, tight plots and sheet-burning sex will love this series. I highly recommend it.

Matthew is back! He had thought he was human and was turned by a vampire Sire who abandoned him so that he had no guidance and had no idea about the supernatural. In Book One: Captive, he was captured by the Incubi, who have been in an age-long war with vampires. Matthew was treated both harshly and with some consideration during his captivity (yes, a bit Stockholm-ish), and still has strong feelings for Tarrick, the Incubi Lord General. And learned he is both Incubus and Vampire. Now, freed by a vampire lord, he's trying, but not succeeding, in getting over those feelings for Tarrick. He's also trying to stay away from both sides and out of all the killing and battles, plus he's mistrusted if not hated by both vampires and incubi. Then he runs into a young girl, Sam, who begs him to help her from being captured by the Incubi. And a strange male, Devak, appears, calling Matthew "prince". And Matthew is drawn back into death and danger--and into the search for answers to his questions about his absent Sire. Second parts of a story can be difficult... but I was as caught up in Matthew's story in this book as I was in the first. His moping for Tarrick was there, but not too bothersome, and encounters with Tarrick helped it become just another cool source of tension. Tension and suspense, there's a lot of, between all the action and the new characters who are introduced to complicate but also enhance Matthew's life. We see his care for both Sam and Davek grow. I loved learning a bit more about the other supernatural beings and their abilities, and their politics and intrigue. The characters, old and new, are an interesting cast. Again, there are a lot of morally grey areas going on with everyone. Matthew remains a pretty sympathetic guy, despite it all. He is loyal and doesn't want to kill people and wants to care for those he loves. He also has a bit of a blood-lust, but it's low on the list. Lots of ugly things happen, but no one really has the moral high ground here... and let's face it, that's pretty true of humans and other creatures as a whole. It definitely seems to work in this complex world. These are the kind of books you want to keep reading forever. Very engrossing. I am sad that I've finished this portion of Matthew's tale, and I can't wait to read more. --And that's how all good reads should be!

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
