

getting used to this. page numbers are not the same as what we use in church. All the info plus more is there though.

All of the text seems to be here, which is important, but it should be noted that the page numbers are not correct. As such, this should not be considered an authorized version. Page numbers might seem like a small matter, but a Book of Common Prayer being used in a church service should have the Holy Eucharsit Rite I begin on Page 323, and Rite II on Page 355. This isn't just a pet peeve of mine. We bought two copies as gifts to our children at their baptism, and when we showed them to three different priests, they were bewildered that such an edition would be in print. It should be fine for personal use, but it would never be acceptable for parish use. We wouldn't have bought these editions had we known. The page numbers could easily be fixed by the publisher, and they should be.

I work for a church that was helping someone from another church with their Jailhouse Ministry. An inmate, who was raised Episcopalian, had requested a visit from our priest and a copy of the BOCP. The rules at the jail require it to be a paperback version only. Absolutely no hardback, no leatherbound, no clothbound or other softcover versions because inmates might hide things inside. Did not realize it would be so difficult to find it in paperback! Fortunately, came through for us. We purchased 4 copies in case we get another request like that one. Thanks !

I love the Book of Common Prayer and was excited for the great price and large print. Unfortunately,

it is useless for leading groups which I do often. Disappointingly, the publishers didn't take care to match the numbers to the standard issue BCP.
