This strong Lemire offering remains solid in this fourth volume. This one is a bit more action-driven than the character-driven third collection. Nguyen's watercolors are fantastic.

Book was good read but had a large crease in it.

There are a number of quality space opera or sci-fi comics right now: *Saga*, *Lazarus*, *Injection*, *Invisible Republic*, and *Bitch Planet*. All of the series began in the middle of the action (though *Saga* has the simplest backstory and explained it fairly early), and even though we are a few years into most of the series, we are still figuring out how the various characters and factions got to where they

currently are. Jeff Lemire has tried to build a multi-world universe where humans are trying to stave off a robot takeover. At the center of it all is Tim-21, a robot that was created to be a friend/brother to boy that lived with his Mom on a remote mining colony. Robots decimated the main world, the humans regrouped, and over 10 years later there is a stalemate. The boy is now a man and he is searching for Tim-21. In fact, every faction is (the story follows at least 4 different groups). Only one new twist was revealed, but the plot moves along swiftly in this volume. We are getting to the meat of the tale now.

This fourth volume deals with different characters as Tim-21, Tim-22, Effie, Driller all end up in situations which seem to be finally bringing this storyline to a close. The conflict between machines and lifeforms is reaching a climax as both sides flex their muscles, hopefully concluded in the next volume. The characters are developed well and makes the whole experience enjoyable. The artwork can be frustrating some times but is generally work a look. Worth a look, especially if you've read the three previous volumes.
