

The information beside the photos is very basic and geared toward younger children. The photos and the information would hopefully be enough to get any child interesting in learning more about the worlds rivers and lakes.

This is an excellent ebook for first graders! As a teacher of elementary students, I would love to incorporate this ebook into a small group activity where I present a main idea or topic to the whole class and then they break up in small groups and discover more material on their own. My mind was

continuously racing as I read through this book thinking of different projects I could make on this topic. It is the perfect age group to let them use a kindle to explore and what a better way to do so than with this ebook! This 18 page downloadable book has beautiful pictures and is an excellent resource for explaining how lakes, rivers and oceans are formed. The definition for each body of water is given along with a simple but detailed explanation of how each is formed. The pictures help make the fast memorable and the reading experience enjoyable. There were very few vocabulary words that needed and explanation in this book, but had words like basin been in bold and added to a glossary, this book would have been perfect. This is by far one of my favorites in the series and will make teaching these concepts easy.I received this item at a discount in exchange for my honest review.

Our kindergarten and first grade children enjoy learning about many different subjects, and books like this are very useful tools.This book very nicely balances text with visuals which I think is very important. Little learners are still very much visual learners and the colorful & detailed pictures help to draw them in and keep them engaged while the simple yet informative text helps little learners understand basic ideas about the subject being presented - in this book that is world lakes and rivers.I liked how the book starts by explaining how rivers are formed and how lakes are made. It's important to understand what you are going to learn about, and the book nicely constructs a foundation for more learning the through imagery and information to take place. I like that the amount of words on each page is not a lot. This is perfect for my 1st Grader. Each page tells you something about either a river and lake, and every other page has an illustration. My son, like most kids, enjoys seeing pictures while he is reading so this is great. My son really enjoyed this book, and it was perfect for his reading level. There are 18 total pages in this book, it's short and sweet. Note that this did not work on Kindle for the PC. I had to use it on either my phone or tablet. First grade geography: Rivers and lakes of the world. This book is divided into 2 main parts. It discusses rivers then goes on to explain lakes. Rivers, I like the time that this book spends on describing what a river is. I think it is written at a level most first graders will be able to understand. It teaches a few important river terms. I like the explanation of the river bed being on the bottom of the banks being the sides of a river. There are many different high quality pictures of rivers. Every page has a picture except for the first page. I think it is important to know where the water in a river comes from. This book lists five sources of water that can form a river. Lakes, This book gives the best definition of a lake that I have ever read. It is accurate, and stated using simple easy to understand words. Again the pictures are great. They show different lakes. This book talks about the 2 types of lakes freshwater, and saltwater. This book also talks about how a lake is formed, and how long they last. Over all I think that this is a great book. It has great educational value, and the pictures are enough to catch the eye of a busy child drawing them in to pay attention. My kids loved me reading this book to them. The pictures had a lot in them, like boats, animals and bridges. These are great learning opportunities. So I ask questions like, what do you see on the river/lake? Letting kids describe in their own words what they are looking at helps them to learn. This is a great introduction to lakes and rivers.
