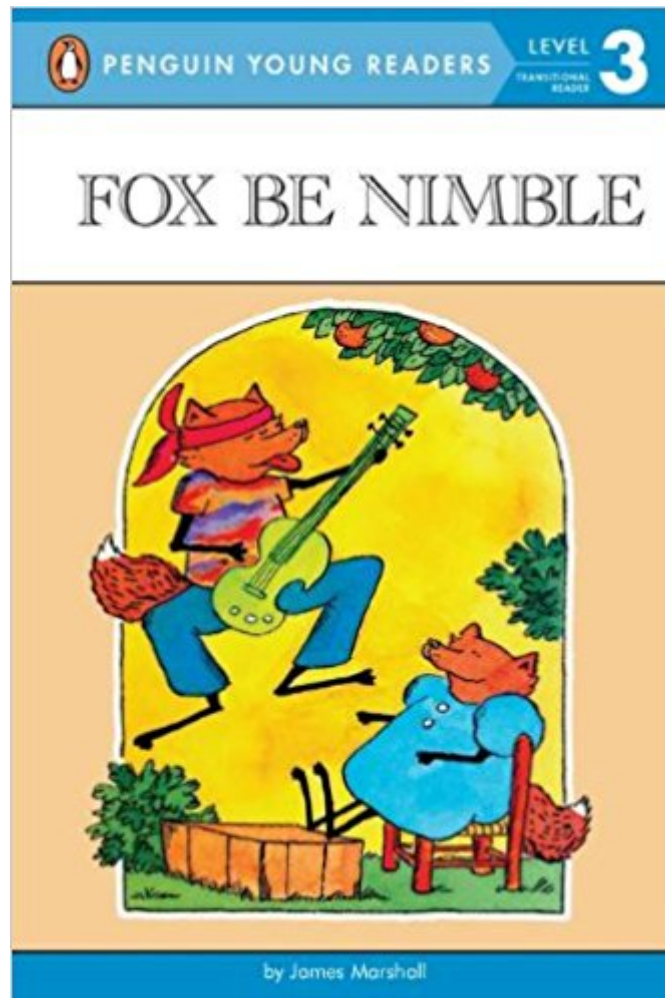

James Marshall was ã  one of the most prolific and successful author/illustrators of children's books. He was best known for his series on the mischievous exploits of Fox, a debonair, lazy showoff; the uproarious adventures of the two Cut-Ups, Spud and Joe; George and Martha; and the misadventures of the Stupidfamily.ã  He divided his time between an apartment in the Chelsea district of New York and his home in Mansfield Hollow Connecticut.

My son loved this book so much that learning to read did not feel like a chore. For a child that enjoys humor, this is the book! The illustrations and Fox's attitude make for an enjoyable book.

We love Fox books. Fox doesn't always have a very good attitude when his mom tells him to do something, but his mom just gives him one of her looks and he obeys! Sometimes, as my 1st grader reads these books, I point out how Fox was disrespectful to his mom initially, and we talk about how he should be respectful and obey.
