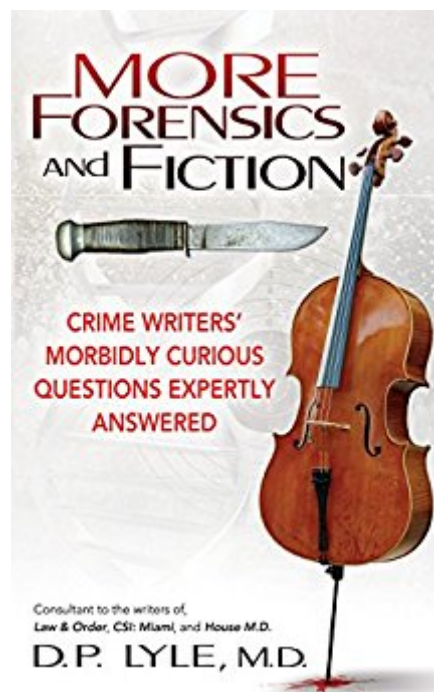

I found a number of authors who were new to me this way. I loved this book on so many levels.

Second in what should be a series by DP Lyle, this is a continuation of answers to questions asked by fiction writers. While the questions may be grisly, curious and odd, the answers are spot on for writers. Any writer will something here, even if it's just entertainment, but for anyone writing a murder, death, crime or other forensic scene, this book can both answer your questions and inspire new options for your work.
