

I'm really glad I bought this, I learned a lot about mosquitoes and how to control them without the use of chemicals and pesticides (yes! It is possible! Even in areas that have huge/dense mosquito populations!) Some of the information was stuff I'd heard before and a very tiny amount was (I felt) inaccurate, but all in all it's good stuff. Lots of new (to me, anyway) info, great tips and good, practical advice. Well written, clear, concise, reader-friendly and very educational. If you would like to enjoy the outside of your home on summer evenings without constantly swatting or scratching yourself raw, you'd be doing well to read this book. You'll learn lots of things about mosquitoes, their life cycle, habitat, feeding and breeding habits, many ways to keep their population in check, and

things you can do to keep them off you. I have a 35 year old female ornate box turtle who likes to roam around the house and her outdoor enclosure in the yard. Ornates are much more carnivorous than most other boxys/tortoises and my girl loves to eat (or at least sample) bugs and other things she finds on the floor or on the ground outside. I do sometimes let her wander around outside of her enclosure (I superglue a small helium balloon to her shell so I can keep track of her) and she eats or at least tastes stuff she finds on the ground all the time. So, I absolutely cannot use pesticides and icky chemicals anywhere that might result in them winding up in an area or in a bug Speedy might explore or eat. She's been my little shelled companion for the past 15 years and I'd just die if anything happened to her! I first read this book when I lived in Louisiana and although I never did totally eradicate the mosquito population around my home there (which I think would really be just about impossible anyway!) I did reduce their numbers enough and learn ways to make my yard, myself and my guests unappetizing enough to impressively reduce the number of biting mosquitoes present at my barbecues/patio parties and thereby very dramatically reducing the number of bites received by everyone attending these events. The first time I tried to do anything outside on a late spring evening in Louisiana I got bit more than 20 times (no, I am not kidding or exaggerating, there were HORDES of the damned things and they were HUNGRY!) Right before I moved out of that home and across the country, I was getting bit maybe once or twice a week. I know, all mosquito bites itch like mad and even a couple can drive you nuts. I am acutely aware of that as I can't use hydrocortisone cream or Calamine due to a weird, rare drug allergy. Oh boy am I aware of the intense itch caused by mosquito bites! However, one or two is definitely an improvement over 20 and I'll take it. I moved to a rural location in Washington state and although the mosquitoes out here are not as numerous and seem much less blood-thirsty than in Louisiana, they were enough of a problem this past summer that I again used the advice & methods outlined in this book to very successfully keep them under control. I might have gotten bit maybe 5 times all this past summer. So, with no chemicals/pesticides but with the addition of some lovely plants that improve the appearance of the outdoor areas I spend the most time around, as well as a few other tricks I got from this book, my box turtle and I can both enjoy our home's outdoor spaces without fear of her eating pesticide-contaminated bugs or me later scratching a few layers of skin off myself. Full of really good information, this book is also well-formatted and easy to read. Some of the mosquito facts are just fascinating, the author has packed A LOT of info into this book while keeping it easy to find specific information quickly. Kudos! Very well done!

This book is written by a man who owns a company that makes a "safe" mosquito control product

that only kills the larvae of the mosquito. His product does target the larvae as opposed to the adult mosquito and is thereby not indiscriminately spraying and killing mosquito predators, so it is safer than, say, spraying DDT. I do have to say that the book is very informative, he definitely knows what he is talking about, and has done some research. The book is not a blatant advertisement for his product, but instead suggests plants for the garden near your outdoor living space, as well as herbs for a homemade mosquito repellent for your skin. I do recommend this book.

When I got this, I thought, "What could you possibly have to say about mosquitoes" more than just listing a few things you can do to deter them. To be frank, I expected this to be a boring read but figured it would be worth it to get "just the facts, mam." Boy was I wrong! The facts in this left me shaking my head in amazement. Also, Steven Tvedten isn't just a guy who went around the internet gathering facts to then throw them into a book. Instead, he was the president of an alternative pest control company 25 years and current president of Prevent Environmental Suicide Today or PEST (Isn't that a cool acronym?!!) He's got more stripes than that, but my point - the guy's an expert is worth listening to! He points out that using traditional chemical methods actually can make the mosquito problem worse, because it kills the mosquito's natural predators too (well - Duh! - why didn't I think of that?!). This book puts you inside the mosquito's head and tells you why, when and where they hunt us - great to know not only to avoid them, but to trap them. I love the techniques to get rid of these guys and after such a good experience here - I look forward to getting the rest of Steven's books! Really - be nice to yourself and your family! Get this book!!! . . . at least the free sample. It costs less than a can of DEET and will save you money, your health, and lotsa scratching!!!
